


Involving young GP's GPRN is a network organisation within

Principles of capacity building









- Overhead: Central office, Web site, Electronic payment system
- Core business:
 - Effective in supporting meeting organizers
 - Effective in supporting Collaborative Studies
 - Effective in organizing Research Courses
- Attractive partner for (academic) experts, whom we need as teachers, key note speakers and role models for junior researchers
- Dependable partner for WONCA, colleges, universities, other networks


Professionalisation needs budget



- Even if we do not do much extra, costs will rise (secretariat, web site, reservation for meetings)
- If we do 'extra' (= continue like we have discussed last meetings) we need budget for: meetings, multi functional interactive website, key notes, teachers, reimbursement of persons who do travel/meet on behalf of EGPRN etc.
- → Agreed on the principles of a New Fee System







- Conference Fee Non-members €200
- Conference Fee Members: €100
- Membership Fee: €300/3years
- Reduced M' Fees:
 - EU countries <70% inc./hd EU: €200/3yrs even more for first attenders from these countries?
 - Direct WONCA members: € 150/3years
 - Students ? Trainees ?




New Fees

- Payment in advance, via web site
- More security for organisers of meetings
- Institutional M' Fee: 600 till 1000 €/3 yrs
 - 2 persons/meeting as 'member'
 - Advisory Board of senior staff
