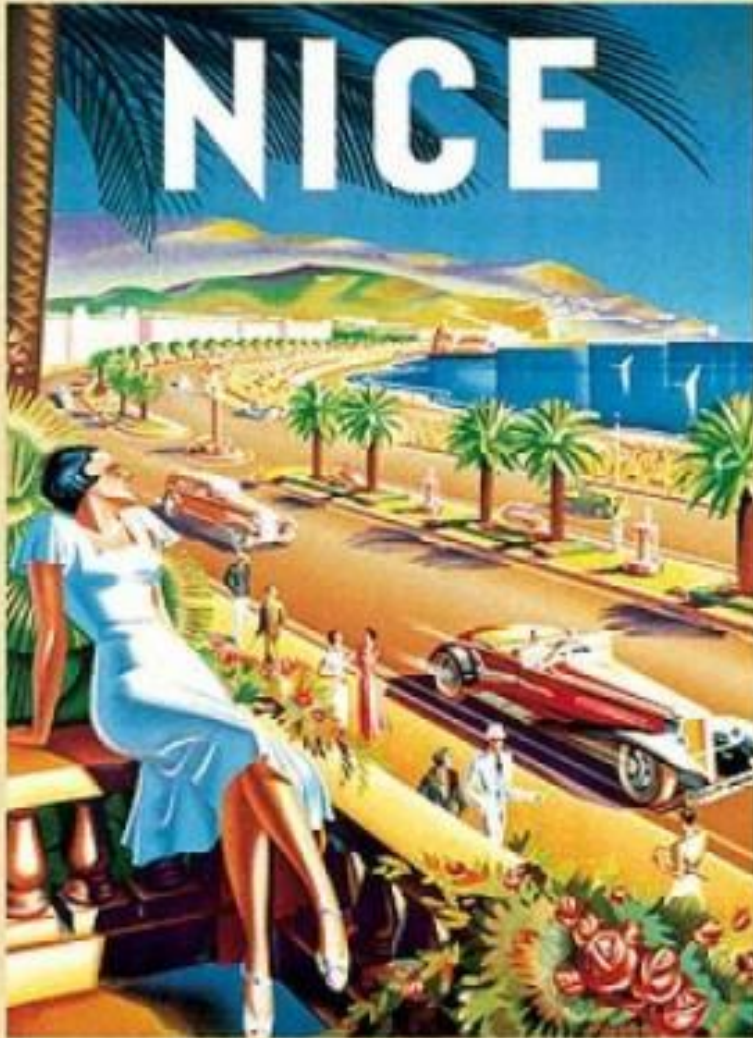

New membership period 2011-2014

- Future full time office in Maastricht
- Stable financial basis for EGPRN based on membership and conference fees, and WONCA Eu subsidy
 - Individual 3 year membership more affordable
 - Competitive conference fees

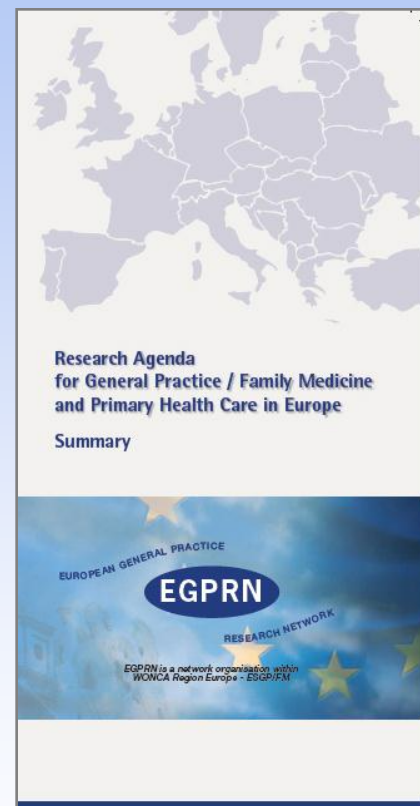
