





Financial situation

- Stable, improved
- Depends on membership fees, conference participation, conference sponsoring
- Less income from WONCA EU??
- Expenses controlled (less expense for office)
- More money for specific activities of EGPRN
 - sponsoring participation of our meetings (up to 75 Eur/participant),
 - collaborative projects (up to 16.000 EUR/year),
 - other EGPRN financial support (up to 2500 EUR grants for low income country participants, young researchers...)


