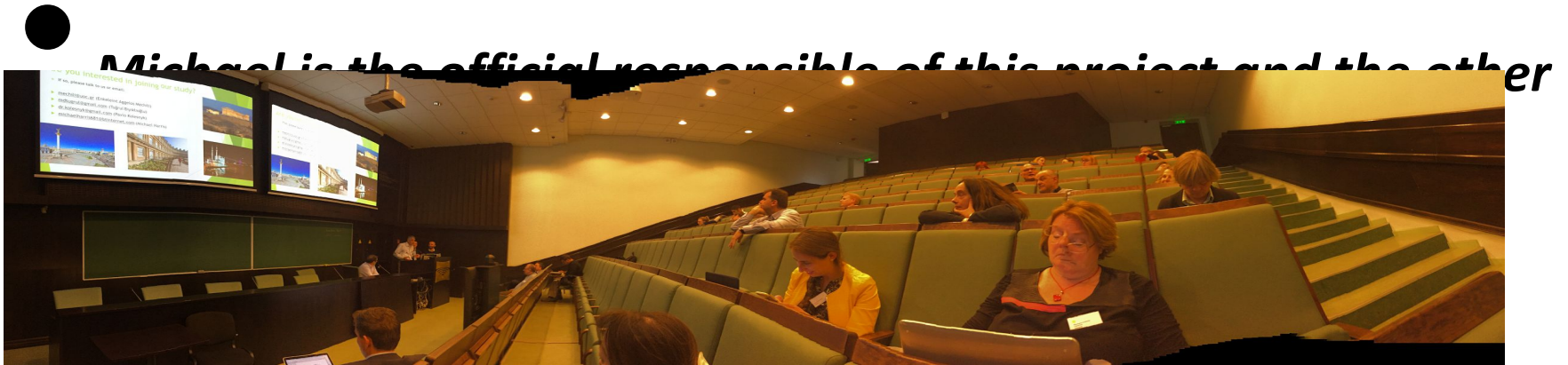

- Every 6 months that small report will be provided to the EB and a feedback to Hanny by the Honorary Secretary (now Davorina).

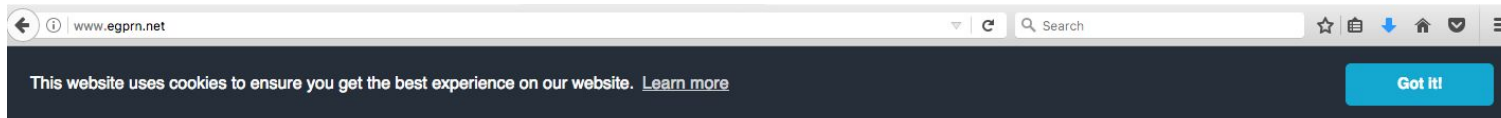
Reducing Costs
