

STATEMENT ON STRENGTHENING PEOPLE-**CENTRED HEALTH SYSTEMS**

Princip health care builds upon interprofessional collaboration to definer a wide range of eccential health care services, which are the key to attaining hould fir off people through the proximins of equitable, affordable and high-quality services. The primary health care team provides services to people and societies encoulitionable from pre-natal to pullistice and end of life care However, primary health care workers are experiencing increasing pressure from new health care structures, ming gallent demand, and scartor resources. Inseptitable resource distribution contrasts sharply with the general acceptance that primary care is the optimum way to deliver efficient and effective health care. Administrators, publicitans and other stakeholders seen to tack understanding about the nature and core services gowided by primary cree professionals.

The organizations supporting this statement wish to support the WHD European Region in orging its Member States, and call for juint action to achieve.

- a) universal health coverage and high quality landy medicine to be implemented and further developed in all baropean construes. This implies allocating researces in accordance with the principles stated in WHO policies;
- b) integration of health care services and promotion of interprofessional teams receiving a strong primary care effectives
- r) stronger links between public health strategies and person-oriented medicine in clinical practice. (d) a rational distribution of ensources driven by the useds of the community.

Addrewindging the need to adopt a person-centred approach in the delivery of health services, we wish to osilerate that

- a) primary sare must be adequately resourced to secure efficient use of health care at all levels.

- a) we support the establishment of strong teams that include all primary builts care protenzionals to meet the changes in needs and demands in the population.

•Chair and Executive Board members, "all", are paying their travel, accommodation, registration and membership fees themselves as a tradition.


